ORDER

The Director of the Office of Lawyers Professional Responsibility has filed a motion for administrative suspension of Richmond Knittel Anaman, alleging that respondent is in arrears in payment of court-ordered child support. The Director has provided proof of the required service of the motion upon respondent and respondent's failure to request a hearing or enter into a written payment agreement as required by Minn. Stat. § 518A.66 (2006).

Based upon an independent review of the motion and supporting documentation, and pursuant to Rule 30, Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility (RLPR),

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent is suspended from the practice of law in Minnesota as provided by Rule 30, RLPR.
2. Respondent shall, within 10 days of the date of filing of this order, provide notice of suspension to all clients, adverse counsel and courts before whom matters are

pending, and shall file an affidavit of compliance with this provision with the Director's Office.

3. Respondent may apply for reinstatement by filing with this court and the Director's Office an affidavit with supporting documentation showing all support arrearages have been paid or that he has entered into and is in compliance with an approved payment agreement with county support authorities, pursuant to Rule 30(c), RLPR.
