R E P R I M A N D

In the Matter of the Application for the Discipline of MARSHALL G. ANDERSON, an Attorney at Law of the State of Minnesota.

It appearing to the court that Respondent Marshall G. Anderson has been found by this court upon his own admission to have violated the Minnesota Code of Professional Responsibility contrary to DR 1-102(A)(1), (3), (4), (5) and (6); and

It further appearing that the Respondent has willingly admitted said violations before this court and has taken steps to make amends therefor; and

It further appearing that Respondent's actions do not constitute a threat to the public,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent Marshall G. Anderson be hereby reprimanded pursuant to Rule 15 of the Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility. His continuance in the practice of law shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. That he will file monthly status reports with the Director of Lawyers Professional Responsibility providing him with such information as may be required by the Director.
2. That he shall confer with the Director of Lawyers Professional Responsibility and make arrangements to complete necessary continuing legal education courses and, if appropriate, may petition the sponsoring organization for waiver of fees in order to complete the same.
3. That Respondent shall not be liable for any costs and disbursements under Rule 24 of the Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility or rules of this court.
