ORDER

WHEREAS, pursuant to Rule 18, Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility, the Director of Lawyers Professional Responsibility has reported to a Lawyers Professional Responsibility Board Panel the conclusions of his investigation of the petition for reinstatement of James E. Bunker; and

WHEREAS, the Director and the Lawyers Board Panel have recommended to the court that James E. Bunker be reinstated to the practice of law in Minnesota upon fulfillment of certain conditions;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that James E. Bunker shall be reinstated to the practice of law in Minnesota upon the following conditions:

1. Prior to reinstatement, respondent shall have successfully completed the multi-state professional responsibility examination required for admission to the practice of law by the State Board of Law Examiners; and
2. Prior to reinstatement, respondent shall also have satisfied the requirements imposed under the rules for Continuing Legal Education on members of the bar as a condition to a change from a restricted to an active status.
