ORDER

On January 6, 2005, the Director of the Office of Lawyers Professional Responsibility filed a motion with this court under Rule 30, Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility (RLPR), for an order administratively suspending the license to practice law of respondent attorney Jacques Trevor Cowan based on notice from Hennepin County Child Support Services that respondent is in arrears in payment of court-ordered child support. Respondent has not entered into an approved payment agreement for such support. Under Rule 30, RLPR, failure to comply with court-ordered child support obligations is grounds for administrative suspension from the practice of law.

Based upon all the files, records and proceedings herein,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:


1. Respondent Jacques Trevor Cowan is suspended from the practice of law in Minnesota pursuant to Rule 30, RLPR;

2. Respondent shall, within 10 days of receipt of this order, notify all clients, counsel and courts in pending matters or active representations of his suspension and shall file an affidavit of compliance with the Director's Office; and

3. Respondent may apply for reinstatement under Rule 30(c), RLPR, by filing with this court and the Director's Office an affidavit, with supporting documentation, demonstrating that his support arrearages have been paid or that he has entered into and is in compliance with an approved payment agreement with county child support authorities.
