WHEREAS, on March 16, 1990, this Court suspended petitioner from the practice of law for a period of 60 days, and

WHEREAS, petitioner has filed with this Court a motion for waiver of Rules 18(a) - (d), Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility, and for permission to comply with Rule 18(e)'s bar examination requirement by successfully completing the professional responsibility portion of the multi-state bar examination within twelve months from the date of reinstatement, and

WHEREAS, the Director does not oppose petitioner's motion, and

WHEREAS, petitioner has filed with this Court an affidavit stating that he has fully complied with the terms of the Court's suspension order other than compliance with Rule 18, and


WHEREAS, the Director of the Office of Lawyers Professional Responsibility has filed with this Court an affidavit certifying that petitioner has complied with the terms of the Court's suspension order other than compliance with Rule 18,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, petitioner is reinstated to the practice of law in the State of Minnesota effective May 15, 1990, subject to petitioner being placed on

two years supervised probation and subject to petitioner successfully completing the professional responsibility portion of the multi-state bar examination by May 15, 1991.
