In Re Petition for Disciplinary Action  
against Alan G. Greenberg an Attorney  
at Law of the State of Minnesota.

ORDER

WHEREAS, the Director of the Office of Lawyers Professional Responsibility has filed a petition, and a supplementary petition, alleging serious misconduct on the part of respondent, Alan G. Greenberg, including misappropriation of settlement funds received on behalf of a client, filing of back-dated and false accounting of the funds with the Director, and requesting that the client falsely state to the Director that she had allowed respondent to use the settlement funds, which she did although later withdrawing the statement; and

WHEREAS, respondent, represented by counsel, waived his right to answer the allegations thereby allowing the petition to be deemed admitted; and

WHEREAS, the respondent and the Director have entered into a stipulation recommending that the appropriate discipline is disbarment and payment of \$750 in costs; and

WHEREAS, this court has independently reviewed the record and agrees that the conduct deemed admitted warrants the agreed-to discipline;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Alan G. Greenberg is disbarred and is ordered to pay \$750 in costs.
