ORDER LAWYERS PROF. RESP. OFFICE

WHEREAS, on February 27, 1995, this Court suspended petitioner, David Gronbeck, from the practice of law for a period of 30 days, and

WHEREAS, this Court, in its order of February 27, 1995, stated that, upon reinstatement, petitioner would be placed on 2 years' supervised probation subject to conditions set out in that order and that respondent is required to successfully complete the professional responsibility portion of the state bar examination by February 27, 1996, and

WHEREAS, petitioner has filed with this court an affidavit stating he has fully complied with requirements for reinstatement set out in this Court's February 27, 1995, order of suspension, and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Office of Lawyers Professional Responsibility has filed with this Court an affidavit stating the Director has no objection to petitioner's reinstatement to the practice of law,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that David Gronbeck is reinstated to the practice of law effective March 29, 1995, and is placed on supervised probation for 2 years subject to the conditions set out by this Court in its order of February 27, 1995, and subject to the requirement that he successfully complete the professional responsibility examination by February 27, 1996.
