ORDER

By petition served upon the respondent Clark F. Isaacs on March 29, 1989, the Director of Lawyers Professional Responsibility charged Mr. Isaacs with certain professional misconduct warranting professional discipline. The respondent interposed an answer to the Director's petition. The Honorable James E. Preece, Judge of the District Court of the Ninth Judicial District for the State of Minnesota, was appointed as referee to hear the evidence and to make a report of his findings of fact, conclusions of law and recommendation.

On July 31, 1989, the referee recommended to this court that Clark F. Isaacs be disbarred from the practice of law. He further recommended that pursuant to Rule 16(e), Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility (RLPR), that Mr. Isaacs be suspended pending the final determination of the disciplinary proceeding. Rule 16(e), RLPR, provides that unless the referee recommends or this court orders to the contrary, the respondent shall be suspended pending final determination of the disciplinary proceeding.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that respondent Clark F. Isaacs is suspended from the practice of law until such time as this court has made a final determination as to what

professional discipline, if any, is appropriate in the pending case.
