against Dean D. Larsen, an Attorney at  
Law of the State of Minnesota.

O R D E R

By petition served upon the respondent Dean D. Larsen on August 4, 1989, the Director of Lawyers Professional Responsibility charged Mr. Larsen with certain professional misconduct warranting professional discipline. The respondent interposed an answer to the Director's petition. The Honorable Jack J. Litman, Judge of the District Court of the Sixth Judicial District for the State of Minnesota, was appointed as referee to hear the evidence and to make a report of his findings of fact, conclusions of law and recommendation.

On December 21, 1989, the referee recommended to this Court that Dean D. Larsen be disbarred from the practice of law. Rule 16(e), Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility, provides that unless the referee recommends or this Court orders to the contrary, the respondent shall be suspended pending final determination of the disciplinary proceeding. The referee did not recommend to the contrary.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that respondent Dean D. Larsen is suspended from the practice of law until such time as this Court has made a final determination as to what professional discipline, if any, is appropriate in the pending case.


