ORDER

On May 2, 2005, the referee appointed to conduct a hearing on the petition for disciplinary action and second amended and supplemental petition for disciplinary action against respondent Daniel Martin Lieber filed his Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendation for Discipline. The referee found that respondent engaged in numerous acts of professional misconduct and recommended that respondent be disbarred. The Director of the Office of Lawyers Professional Responsibility has filed a request for interim suspension of respondent pending a final determination of the disciplinary proceeding under Rule 16(e), Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility (RLPR), which provides that upon a referee's recommendation of disbarment, "the lawyer's authority to practice law shall be suspended pending final determination of the disciplinary proceeding, unless the referee directs otherwise or the Court orders otherwise." The referee did not direct that respondent should not be placed on interim suspension. Respondent has not filed a response to the request for interim suspension. We conclude that interim suspension under Rule 16(e), RLPR, is warranted.


