WHEREAS, on October 23, 1987, this Court suspended James Malcolm Williams from the practice of law for a period of six months from October 30, 1987, and


WHEREAS, James Malcolm Williams has filed with this Court an affidavit stating that he has fully complied with the terms of the Court's suspension order, and
