ORDER

WHEREAS, on August 12, 1988, this Court suspended Robert Munns from the practice of law for a period of two years, commencing one week from the date of the order, and

WHEREAS, this Court in its suspension order stayed all but 30 days of the suspension subject to various conditions, and


WHEREAS, Robert Munns has filed with this Court an affidavit stating that he has fully complied with the terms of the Court's suspension order to the extent required up to this date, and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Office of Lawyers Professional Responsibility has filed with this Court an affidavit certifying that Robert Munns has complied with the terms of the suspension order to the extent required to date.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, Robert Munns is reinstated to the practice of law in the State of Minnesota effective September 18, 1988, subject to the conditions for the stay of the two-year suspension as set forth in this Court's order of August 12, 1988.
