**PETITION FOR
DISCIPLINARY ACTION**

TO THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

The Director of the Office of Lawyers Professional Responsibility, hereinafter Director, files this petition upon the parties' agreement pursuant to Rules 10(a) and 12(a), Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility. The Director alleges:

The above-named attorney, hereinafter respondent, was admitted to practice law in Minnesota on May 9, 2008. Respondent currently resides in Rockford, Minnesota.

Respondent has committed the following unprofessional conduct warranting public discipline:

FIRST COUNT

1. In April 2010 respondent was charged with criminal sexual conduct in the second degree. (Ex. 1.)

2. Respondent pled guilty to criminal sexual conduct in the fourth degree, in violation of Minn. Stat. § 609.345, subdiv. 1(b), a felony. On August 6, 2010, respondent was sentenced. (Ex. 2.)

3. Rule 19(a), RLPR, provides:

Criminal Conviction. A lawyer's criminal conviction in any American jurisdiction * * * is, in proceedings under these Rules, conclusive evidence

that the lawyer committed the conduct for which the lawyer was convicted.

4. Respondent's conduct violated Rule 8.4(b), Minnesota Rules of Professional Conduct.

WHEREFORE, the Director respectfully prays for an order of this Court suspending respondent or imposing otherwise appropriate discipline, awarding costs and disbursements pursuant to the Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility, and for such other, further or different relief as may be just and proper.
