**STIPULATION FOR
RECIPROCAL DISCIPLINE**

THIS STIPULATION is entered into by and between Martin A. Cole, Director of the Office of Lawyers Professional Responsibility, hereinafter Director, and James R. Bullis, attorney, hereinafter respondent.

WHEREAS, respondent has concluded it is in respondent's best interest to enter into this stipulation,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the undersigned as follows:

1. It is understood that respondent has certain rights pursuant to Rule 12(d), Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility (RLPR). Respondent waives those rights and agrees to the Court's immediate issuance of an order for discipline consistent with this stipulation. Respondent hereby admits service of the petition for reciprocal discipline.

2. Respondent admits the allegations of the petition which may be summarized as follows: On November 13, 2006, respondent's North Dakota law license was suspended by the North Dakota Supreme Court for a period of 90 days for respondent's conflicts of interest in the handling of a series of business matters, which acts violated the N.D.R.P.C., and also violated Rules 1.7(a), (b) and (c), and 1.8(a) and (b), Minnesota Rules of Professional Conduct.

3. Respondent affirmatively asserts, and has provided the Director with evidence, that he has not practiced law in Minnesota while suspended in North Dakota, and further that respondent currently has no clients in Minnesota.

4. Respondent understands that by entering into this stipulation, the Director is not making any representations as to the sanction the Court will impose.

5. The Director and respondent join in recommending that:

a. The appropriate discipline is a reciprocal 90-day suspension pursuant to Rule 15, RLPR, stayed pursuant to the following conditions;

b. Respondent comply with Rule 26(e), RLPR, to the extent applicable; and;

c. Respondent pay \$900 in costs pursuant to Rule 24(a), RLPR.

6. This stipulation is entered into by respondent freely and voluntarily, without any coercion, duress or representations by any person except as contained herein.

7. Respondent hereby acknowledges receipt of a copy of this stipulation.

8. Respondent has been advised by the undersigned counsel concerning this stipulation and these proceedings generally.


