**STIPULATION  
FOR DISBARMENT**

THIS STIPULATION is entered into by and between Martin A. Cole, Director of the Office of Lawyers Professional Responsibility, hereinafter Director, and Terry Lynn Djonne, hereinafter respondent.

WHEREAS, respondent has concluded it is in respondent's best interest to enter into this stipulation,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the undersigned as follows:

1. On October 10, 2007, respondent pled *nolo contendere* to a felony theft by swindle charge. Pursuant to Rule 10(c), Rule on Lawyers Professional Responsibility (RLPR), a petition for disciplinary action, hereinafter petition, was approved by the Lawyers Professional Responsibility Board Chair. Respondent agrees to the immediate filing of the petition in the Minnesota Supreme Court.
2. The Director and respondent stipulate that paragraph 19 of the petition for disciplinary action shall be amended to read that respondent pled *nolo contendere* to felony theft by swindle.

3. Respondent understands that upon the filing of this stipulation and the petition, this matter will be of public record.

4. It is understood that respondent has certain rights pursuant to Rule 14, RLPR. Respondent waives these rights, which include the right to a hearing before a referee on the petition; to have the referee make findings and conclusions and a recommended disposition; to contest such findings and conclusions; and to a hearing before the Supreme Court upon the record, briefs and arguments. Respondent hereby admits service of the petition.

5. Respondent waives the right to answer and unconditionally admits the allegations of the amended petition filed herewith.

6. Respondent understands that based upon these admissions, this Court may impose any of the sanctions set forth in Rule 15(a)(1) - (9), RLPR, including making any disposition it deems appropriate. Respondent understands that by entering into this stipulation, the Director is not making any representations as to the sanction the Court will impose.

7. The parties recommend that the appropriate discipline is disbarment pursuant to Rule 15, RLPR.

8. This stipulation is entered into by respondent freely and voluntarily, without any coercion, duress or representations by any person except as contained herein.

9. Respondent hereby acknowledges receipt of a copy of this stipulation.

10. Respondent has been advised of the right to be represented herein by an attorney but has freely chosen to appear *pro se*.
