**PETITION FOR
DISCIPLINARY ACTION**

TO THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

The Director of the Office of Lawyers Professional Responsibility, hereinafter Director, files this petition seeking reciprocal discipline pursuant to Rule 12(d), Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility. The Director alleges:

The above-named attorney, hereinafter respondent, was admitted to practice law in Minnesota on July 23, 1998. Respondent's address on file with the lawyer registration office is in Chicago, Illinois. Respondent was suspended on April 1, 2013, for non-payment of attorney registration fees.

On November 20, 2013, respondent was disbarred from the practice of law in the State of Illinois. Respondent's disbarment arose out of his conviction of conspiracy to distribute 1000 kilograms or more of marijuana. Attached as Exhibits 1 through 4, respectively, are (1) July 8, 2011, disciplinary complaint against Mr. Huff; (2) January 15, 2013, report and recommendation of the Illinois Attorney Registration and Disciplinary Commission Hearing Board; (3) August 29, 2013, decision on the Illinois Attorney Registration and Disciplinary Commission Review Board, and (4) November 20, 2013,

disbarment order. Respondent's misconduct violated Rule 8.4(a)(3) and (5), Illinois Rules of Professional Conduct.¹


WHEREFORE, the Director respectfully prays for an order of this Court directing that respondent and the Director inform the Court within thirty days of its order whether either or both believe the imposition of identical discipline by the Minnesota Supreme Court would be unwarranted and the reasons for that claim.
