TO THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:


The Director of the Office of Lawyers Professional Responsibility, hereinafter Director, files this petition seeking reciprocal discipline pursuant to Rule 12(d), Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility (RLPR). The Director alleges:

The above-named attorney, hereinafter respondent, was admitted to practice law in Minnesota on April 5, 1993. Respondent's Minnesota law license is currently voluntarily CLE restricted. Respondent currently practices in Parker, Colorado.

On June 27, 2014, pursuant to stipulation by the parties, the Colorado Supreme Court suspended respondent's law license for 60 days, stayed upon the successful completion of a two-year probation, with conditions. As more fully set forth in the court's order (Exhibit 1) and stipulation (Exhibit 2), the basis for respondent's discipline was a guilty plea to one count of harassment/insult/taunts/challenges stemming from a road rage incident. Respondent's misconduct, as stated in Exhibits 1 and 2, violated Rule 8.4(b) and (c), Minnesota Rules of Professional Conduct.

WHEREFORE, the Director respectfully prays for an order of this Court imposing identical discipline as that imposed against respondent by the Colorado Supreme Court.
