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**PETITION FOR  
DISCIPLINARY ACTION**

TO THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Upon the approval of the Chair of the Lawyers Professional Responsibility Board, the Director of the Office of Lawyers Professional Responsibility, hereinafter Director, files this petition pursuant to Rules 10(c) and 12(a), Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility (RLPR). The Director alleges:

The above-named attorney, hereinafter respondent, was admitted to practice law in Minnesota on May 8, 1998. Respondent currently practices law in St. Paul, Minnesota.

As more particularly alleged below, on November 26, 2012, respondent pled guilty to a crime, filing false tax returns in violation of 26 U.S.C. § 7206(1), a necessary element of which is misrepresentation within the meaning of Rule 10(c), RLPR.

Respondent has committed the following unprofessional conduct warranting public discipline:

FIRST COUNT

1. On November 26, 2012, respondent pled guilty to a crime, tax fraud, in violation of 26 U.S.C. § 7206(1), which is punishable by incarceration for a period greater than one year and a necessary element of which is misrepresentation (Exs. 1-2).


2. From 2006 through 2010, inclusive, respondent underreported his income by a total of more than \$420,000, resulting in a total tax loss of more than \$100,000 (Ex. 2).

3. On April 9, 2013, respondent was sentenced. Respondent is to be imprisoned for eight months beginning May 21, 2013, and upon release from custody will be on supervised release for one year (Ex. 2).

4. Respondent's conduct violated Rule 8.4(b) and (c), Minnesota Rules of Professional Conduct.

WHEREFORE, the Director respectfully prays for an order of this Court suspending respondent or imposing otherwise appropriate discipline, awarding costs and disbursements pursuant to the Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility, and for such other, further or different relief as may be just and proper.

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
