**STIPULATION FOR
RECIPROCAL DISCIPLINE**

THIS STIPULATION is entered into by and between Martin A. Cole, Director of the Office of Lawyers Professional Responsibility, hereinafter Director, and Mark Edward Robinson, attorney, hereinafter respondent.

WHEREAS, respondent has concluded it is in respondent's best interest to enter into this stipulation,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the undersigned as follows:

1. It is understood that respondent has certain rights pursuant to Rule 12(d), Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility (RLPR). Respondent waives those rights and agrees to the Court's immediate issuance of an order for reciprocal discipline consistent with this stipulation. Respondent hereby admits service of the petition for disciplinary action.
2. Respondent unconditionally admits the allegations of the petition which may be summarized as follows: On June 24, 2005, respondent's Wisconsin law license was suspended by the Wisconsin Supreme Court for a period of six months for multiple acts of misconduct in the handling of various real estate transactions, which acts violated Rules 1.7(a), 1.7(b), 4.2, 5.3(c)(1), 8.4(a) and 8.4(c), Minnesota Rules of Professional Conduct. Respondent failed to inform the Director of the Wisconsin disciplinary proceeding or the suspension of his Wisconsin license, as required by Rule 12(d), RLPR.
3. Respondent understands that by entering into this stipulation, the Director is not making any representations as to the sanction the Court will impose.

4. The Director and respondent join in recommending that the appropriate discipline is a six month suspension. The reinstatement hearing provided for in Rule 18, RLPR, is not waived. Reinstatement is conditioned upon: (a) payment of costs in the amount of \$900 pursuant to Rule 24(d), RLPR; (b) compliance with Rule 26, RLPR; (c) successful completion of the professional responsibility examination pursuant to Rule 18(e); and (d) satisfaction of the continuing legal education requirements pursuant to Rule 18(e), RLPR.

5. This stipulation is entered into by respondent freely and voluntarily, without any coercion, duress or representations by any person except as contained herein.

6. Respondent hereby acknowledges receipt of a copy of this stipulation.

7. Respondent has consulted with his Wisconsin counsel and been advised of the right to be represented by an attorney in Minnesota, but has freely chosen to appear *pro se*.


