**SUPPLEMENTARY PETITION
FOR DISCIPLINARY ACTION**

TO THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

The Director of the Office of Lawyers Professional Responsibility, hereinafter Director, files this supplementary petition for disciplinary action pursuant to Rules 10(e) and 12(a), Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility (RLPR).

Respondent is currently the subject of a February 6, 2014, petition for disciplinary action. The Director has investigated further allegations of unprofessional conduct against respondent.

The Director alleges that respondent has committed the following additional unprofessional conduct warranting public discipline:

FOURTH COUNT

Additional failure to cooperate:

39. On January 14, 2014, the Director served on respondent charges of unprofessional conduct, notice of panel procedures and notice of panel assignment. The notice of panel procedures informed respondent that he had 14 days in which to submit an answer to the charges. Respondent failed to respond.

40. On February 4, 2014, the Director filed a motion with the Lawyers Professional Responsibility Board Panel Chair to approve the filing of a petition for

disciplinary action based on respondent's failure to answer the charges. Respondent failed to respond to the motion.

41. On March 3, 2014, the Director mailed to Respondent notice of investigation of a complaint filed by Prince C. Togbeson against respondent. The complaint alleges that, in October 2010, respondent began representation of complainant and complainant's family in a personal injury matter, that thereafter respondent failed to communicate with complainant and his family and respondent has failed to provide complainant's file to him. The notice of investigation requested respondent to provide his complete written response to the complaint within 14 days of the date of the notice. Respondent failed to respond.

42. By letter dated March 18, 2014, the Director informed respondent that the Director had received no response to Togbeson's complaint and requested respondent to provide at that time his complete written response as requested in the notice of investigation. Respondent failed to respond.

43. By letter dated March 26, 2014, the Director informed respondent that the Director had received no response to Togbeson's complaint and requested respondent to provide at that time his complete written response as requested in the notice of investigation. Respondent failed to respond.


44. By letter dated April 4, 2014, the Director informed respondent that the Director had received no response to Togbeson's complaint and requested respondent to provide at that time his complete written response as requested in the notice of investigation. Respondent failed to respond.

45. To date, respondent has failed to respond to Togbeson's complaint or otherwise communicate with the Director regarding the Togbeson matter.

46. Respondent's conduct violated Rules 8.1(b), Minnesota Rules of Professional Conduct, and Rule 25, Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility.


