ORDER

 Petition, Answer, and Stipulation having been filed
 herein, the matter came duly on for hearing before the Supreme
 Court in Chambers, Oscar K. Knutson, Chief Justice, presiding,
 in the State Capitol, City of St. Paul, Minnesota, on the 30th
 day of March, 1975. The Court being fully advised in the premi-
 ses, now, upon motion of R. B. Reavill, as Administrative Director
 on Professional Conduct, Petitioner herein, concurred in by Re-
 spondent and the State Board of Professional Responsibility, and
 upon Stipulation between the respective parties in this proceed-
 ing, makes the following

ORDERS:

1. Respondent Ellsworth I. Serstock is hereby
 and as of this date placed on probation
 until further order of the court, the terms
 and conditions of the probation to be as
 follows:
 - (a) That Respondent refrain from the use
 of alcohol;
 - (b) That Respondent shall conduct his
 practice of law in accordance with the

Code of Professional Responsibility
of the American Bar Association as
adopted by the Supreme Court of
Minnesota;

(c) That Respondent shall enter into
agreements with the Minnesota Depart-
ment of Taxation and the Internal
Revenue Service, satisfactory to them,
for the settlement of Respondent's
income tax liabilities, and that in
the future, Respondent shall make
timely filings of both State and
Federal returns.

(d) That Respondent shall enter into
agreements with Petitioner, satisfactory
to Petitioner, for the supervision of
his activities.

2. Upon a showing to the Court, satisfactory to the
Court, that Respondent has failed to comply with
the conditions of his probation, he shall be
forthwith suspended indefinitely from the practice
of law in the State of Minnesota. Such showing
may be made by affidavits or otherwise and with-
out any hearing before a referee or any formal
hearing before the Supreme Court.
