ORDER

On April 8, 1991, the Lawyers Professional Responsibility Board, through its Director, filed with this Court a petition alleging that the respondent, Mark H. Stromwall, has misappropriated client funds, attempted to defraud a client out of more than \$8,000 and committed various trust account violations. Thereafter, the Director and the respondent entered into a stipulation in which the respondent agreed to dispense with proceedings under Rule 16, Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility, and in which the respondent agreed that the Court may enter its order suspending the respondent from the practice of law pending final determination of these disciplinary proceedings.

The Court, having considered all of the facts and circumstances surrounding this matter, the petition of the Director, and the stipulation of the parties, NOW ORDERS:

1. That, effective June 1, 1991, the respondent, Mark H. Stromwall, shall be temporarily suspended from the practice of law pending final determination of these disciplinary proceedings, pursuant to Rule 16, Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility.


2. That, on or before June 1, 1991, respondent shall notify each of his clients of his inability to continue representation of the client and otherwise shall comply fully

with the provisions of Rule 26 and Rule 27, Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility.

3. That the June 6, 1991 hearing in this matter hereby is cancelled.
