PUBLIC REPRIMAND


It appearing to the court that Respondent Fred G. Vogel has been found by the court's referee, the Honorable Paul Hoffman, to have violated the Minnesota Code of Professional Responsibility by transacting business with a client, resulting in an impermissible conflict of interests, prejudicial to the administration of justice; and

It further appearing that Respondent has cooperated with the county court and Lawyers Professional Responsibility Board, and has made amends by settling accounts with the client's guardian,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent Fred G. Vogel be, and he hereby is publicly reprimanded; and his resignation as a member of the bar of Minnesota is hereby accepted on the following conditions:

1. He will not apply for admission to the bar of any other jurisdiction;
2. He will assume liability for costs and disbursements in the sum of \$713.55, payable to the Lawyers Professional Responsibility Board on or before June 1, 1982.
