NEW YEAR'S RESOLUTIONS

- 7. I will make timely filings of both Federal and State income tax returns.
- 8. I will promptly pay all indebtedness incurred by me on behalf of clients unless I make it clear to the person furnishing such services that he must look to my client for payment.
- 9. I will avoid even the appearance of impropriety in both my professional and personal life.
- 10. I will remember at all times that I am a member of an honorable profession and conduct myself as such.
